

Flex-Fuel Vehicle Production Numbers

Ford:

With the introduction of four new 2006 models that have the E85 option - including the Ford F-150 pickup, Ford Crown Victoria, Mercury Grand Marquis and Lincoln Town Car - the company will produce up to 250,000 ethanol-capable vehicles in 2006.

GM:

Today, GM is a leader in producing E85 FlexFuel vehicles with more than 1.5 million of them on the road in the U.S. and plans to produce 400,000 more vehicles in 2006.

Chrysler:

E85-capable Dodge Stratus sedans, minivans and Dodge Ram pickups. DaimlerChrysler has sold about 1.5 million FFVs, and will market more than 250,000 in 2007 and nearly 500,000 in 2008.
