Award Description:

This organization has recognized the environmental, economic and national security benefits of reducing consumption of fossil fuels and has implemented programs and initiatives to lower their use of traditional transportation fuels. These activities include, but are not limited to: purchasing alternative fuel and/or fuel efficient vehicles, using alternative fuels in their fleet, implementing idle reduction policies, improving fleet fuel economy, partnering with fuel providers to expand alternative fuel availability, and generally supporting and participating in current CCFC/Clean Cities programs and priorities.

Nomination Process:

Please submit a one-page narrative describing why your organization or an organization you wish to nominate should be considered for this award. The narrative should include specifics on programs or activities that the organization has implemented that reduce the consumption of fossil fuels. Please include contact information for the nominated organization and contact information for the nominee. And, if you need assistance preparing a nomination narrative, please let us know.
